

### Schüssler-Salts for Kitty and the likes

### **THE BIOCHEMIC HOME MEDICINE CHEST FOR ANIMALS**

Those who have pets know the feeling: When the fourlegged companion doesn't feel well, one also suffers. After all, cats, dogs, guinea pigs, etc., are unable to tell us where exactly the problem is or how painful it is. As specialists are able to best assess symptoms, injuries, or wounds, a visit to the vet should be self-evident. Once a clinical report exists, the suggested treatment can easily be supported with natural measures – an easy and effective method are the minerals according to Dr Schüssler.

Particularly clingy, extremely withdrawn, perhaps also unusually aggressive – with their behaviour, animals show us when something is wrong. It makes no difference if it concerns a horse or a hamster. With attentiveness and good observational skills, animal owners quickly recognise when an animal is sick. When the animal is lame and limps, permanently scratches, coughs, or has diarrhoea, the need for action is easily recognised. But in case of unspecific symptoms, when the animal seems apathetic, or doesn't eat, one should not take a risk and seek help.

The animal's diet should also always be considered. A diet lacking in specifically necessary proteins, vitamins, and minerals can lead to acidosis, problems with kidneys, bladder, or skin for example.

However, some typical problems can easily be treated by the owners. For instance, a cold pack in case of bruises or insect bites. And Schüssler-Salts. To relieve inflammations or pain, mainly three Schüssler-Salts are of benefit in the home medicine chest.

- Salt No. 3 Ferrum phosphate 12X is the fire brigade in the therapy. It mobilises the immune system and, as the acute remedy assists in curbing commencing infections and inflammations – no matter if coughs and sneezes, diarrhoea, a cracked claw, or inflammatory problems on the hock. Example – a dog with a gum infection was treated with No. 3 Ferrum phosphate 12X, redness and swelling in the mouth clearly abated after one day. To allow a deep and rapid effect of the remedy, it is recommended to give 1 tablet every hour (up to 6 times a day) in acute situations, until the symptoms subside, or one can get to the vet.
- Salt No.6 Potassium phosphate 6X is recommended as the nerve remedy. It has a calming and strengthening effect when the animal suffers from shock after an injury for example. Good experiences with the use of No. 5 have been achieved in anxious, scared animals, or in stressful situations.
- Salt No. 7 Magnesium phosphate 6X is the remedy for pain conditions in the mineral therapy according to Dr Schüssler. It is effective in muscle tensions and -cramps, as they often occur in older animals, change in weather, or when a dog has romped around in water a lot. Magnesium phosphate also assists in colics, and gastrointestinal problems, for instance after a change of feed.




# Sucking not possible – How to administer the Salts

It is ideal, when the minerals, like in humans, can be dissolved in the mouth, where they are directly absorbed via the oral mucosa. As the tablets are based on lactose and thus have a slightly sweet taste, the animal will usually take them from the hand without a problem. But not always! Therefore, the most tried and tested method is to dissolve the dose in some water, draw up a disposable syringe and directly apply to the mouth or muzzle. Animals who absolutely do not tolerate this can be outfoxed: Mix and offer the tablets with a treat. The recommended dose is as follows: large dogs get 2 tablets, medium-sized and small dogs, as well as cats get 1 tablet. Small rodents get ½ a tablet.

## **BODY-CLEANSING COURSE OF TREATMENT FOR THE HUMAN BODY**

This course of treatment stimulates detoxification and metabolism and has a deacidifying and vitalising effect on the body. It is particularly ideal as a springtime-cure but can of course be applied anytime during the year.

Duration of treatment: Three to six weeks.

### **Recommended Salts**

- ✓ No. 18 Calcium sulfuratum 6X
- ✓ No. 23 Natrium bicarbonicum 6X
- ✓ No. 2 Calcium phosphate 6X
- ✓ No. 6 Potassium sulphate 6X
- ✓ No. 10 Sodium sulphate 6X

#### Administration:

Dissolve two to four tablets of each salt in half a litre of hot water, allow to cool, then pour into a water bottle and slowly sip the solution during the day (the more sips the better). Keep each sip in the mouth for a few moments before swallowing.

### This promotes Success

- Tea, prepared from fennel seeds (250g), anise (100g), liquorice (50g), caraway (50g) douse 1 tbsp of the mixture with one litre boiling water, allow to infuse for 5 minutes. Drink 2 litres each day.
- To stimulate intestinal activity, liberally apply No. 10 Sodium sulphate Cream to the abdomen.
